IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Light and Signals on Fire Apparatus.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section Ninety-nine of Chapter Two Hundred and Eleven of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one, as amended by Section Two of Chapter One Hundred and Forty-one of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-three, is hereby amended by striking out all of said Section Ninety-nine and substituting in place thereof the following:

'Sect. 99. The provisions of this chapter governing the equipment or use of lights or danger signals on motor vehicles, shall not apply to motor vehicles owned or controlled by municipalities or village corporations, and used for fire fighting purposes.'
