STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Ice Fishing in Mousam Lake, Square Lake and Goose Pond, Situated in the Towns of Shapleigh and Acton, in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 38, sec. 21, relating to Ice Fishing in Mousam Lake, Square Lake and Goose Pond, Situated in the Towns of Shapleigh and Acton, in York County.

Sect. twenty-one of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended in inserting in the sixteenth line of the twentieth paragraph thereof after the words "York County" the following: 'except during the month of February', so that the portion of said twentieth paragraph relating to Mousam Lake, Square Lake and Goose Pond shall read as follows:

'Mousam Lake (1929, c. 335), Square Lake, and Goose pond situated in the towns of Shapleigh and Acton in York county, except during the month of February;'
