AN ACT Opening Ladd Brook to Fishing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Ladd Brook, so called, in the town of Abbot, is hereby
opened to all fishing in the same manner as Kingsbury stream
and Thorn brook in the town of Kingsbury.
