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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

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AN ACT to repeal section two of chapten ten of the private  
and special acts of eighteen hundred eighty seven, entitled:  
“An act additional to the acts which constitute the charter  
of Colby University.”

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter ten of the private and  
special acts of eighteen hundred eighty seven entitled:

“An act additional to the acts which constitute the charter  
of Colby University,” and reading:

“In addition to the property so held, said president and  
trustees of Colby University may take and hold, for the pur-  
poses specified in its charter, property real and personal to  
an amount, that the annual clear income of the same shall  
not exceed the sum of fifty thousand dollars instead of the  
amount specified in its charter,” is hereby repealed.
