STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Authorize the Merging of Pine Grove Cemetery of Portland, Maine, with Evergreen Cemetery of Portland, Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Pine Grove Cemetery Association, a corporation organized and existing by law, and located in Portland, in the County of Cumberland, is hereby authorized to transfer and convey its assets and obligations to the City of Portland, the territory comprised within the limits of said Pine Grove Cemetery to be annexed to and become a part of Evergreen Cemetery, such action to be taken after such notice to the members of Pine Grove Cemetery Association as provided in the by-laws of said Association, and by the statutes of Maine, and upon such terms and conditions as its members may vote.

Sect. 2. Said City of Portland is hereby authorized to take over and acquire the assets and obligations of said Pine Grove Cemetery Association on such terms and conditions as the city council of the City of Portland may vote and annex the territory within limits of said Pine Grove Cemetery to said Evergreen Cemetery.
