HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Opening Upper Ebemee Pond to Ice Fishing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Upper Ebemee Pond opened to ice fishing. Upper Ebemee pond, in township four, range nine, N. W. P., township B, range ten, W. E. L. S., in the county of Piscataquis, is hereby opened to ice fishing under the provisions of the general law.

Sect. 2. Penalty for violation. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall be subject to the general penalty provided in section one hundred seven of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes for violation of the fish and game laws.
