IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide a Penalty for Circulating False Reports
Concerning Banks and Loan and Building Associations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whoever maliciously makes, publishes, utters, repeats, or circulates any false report concerning any savings bank, trust company or loan and building association shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall upon conviction in any court of competent jurisdiction be fined not more than one thousand dollars or imprisoned for not more than eleven months, or both.
