AN ACT to Extend the Free Employment Service.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Free employment service extended. Chapter fifty-four of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting a new section to be numbered 10A and to read as follows:

'Sect. 10A. Cooperating with Federal department on free employment service. The department of labor and industry shall cooperate with the Federal department of labor in extending the free employment service carried on in this state by the said Federal department.

For the purpose of carrying on this work there shall be paid in to the account of the department of labor and industry on July first of each fiscal year the sum of five thousand dollars.'
