STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Ice Fishing in Grand Lake, Washington
County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

It shall be lawful for citizens of the State, and non-residents, licensed as provided by Section nineteen, of Chapter thirty-eight, of the Revised Statutes of Maine, to take land-locked salmon, trout, togue and white perch, in Grand Lake, the outlet of which is Grand Lake Stream, in Washington County, with not more than five set lines to each family, when fishing through the ice in the day time, and when under the immediate supervision of the person fishing, during the months of February, and March each year.
