IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Opening Wilson Lake to Ice Fshing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Wilson Lake, situated in the towns of Monmouth, Winthrop and Wayne, is hereby opened to ice fishing for pickerel and white perch for each Saturday during the months of February and March.
