STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Fishing for Smelts in Damariscotta
River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Seine fishing of smelts in Damariscotta river. It shall be lawful to fish for or take smelts by the use of seines in the Damariscotta river as far up said river as The Ledges, so called, which place is near the northerly limits of the town of South Bristol.

Sect. 2. P. & S. L., 1923, c. 71, repealed. Chapter seventy-one of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred twenty-three is hereby repealed.
