AN ACT Relating to Fly Fishing in the St. John River
Tributaries

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, sec. 21; fly fishing in St. John River tributaries. Section twenty-one of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the words "as far as" in the ninth line of the sixteenth paragraph of said section the words 'the west line of the plantation of' so that the portion of said sixteenth paragraph relating to the St. John River tributaries, as amended, shall read as follows: 'and in the tributaries to the St. John River, down as far as the west line of the plantation of St. Francis in the county of Aroostook and in the tributaries to the Allagash river;'
