STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Itinerant Vendors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 26 of chapter 46 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out all of said section after the word "delivery" in the fourth line thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following: 'nor to sales of farm, dairy and orchard products made by the bona fide producers thereof in the State of Maine, nor to sales of bark, wood and forest products,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'The provisions of the fifteen preceding sections shall not apply to sales made to dealers by commercial travelers or selling agents in the usual course of business, nor to bona fide sales of goods, wares and merchandise by sample for future delivery, nor to sales of farm, dairy and orchard products made by the bona fide producers thereof in the State of Maine, nor to sales of bark, wood and forest products.'
