IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Construction of State Aid Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Commission empowered to tar surface from joint fund. The commission may, at its discretion, in any year set aside from the joint fund provided by this chapter for the construction of state aid highways in any town a sum not exceeding the rate of one thousand dollars per mile of the road estimated to be constructed, provided said sum is used for the purpose of applying tar to the way so constructed within ten months from the time such year's construction is completed.
