## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Secretary of State Authorized to Destroy Records More Than Two Years Old.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, sec. 121; relating to secretary of state authorized to destroy records more than five years old. Section one hundred twenty-one of chapter twenty-nine of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word "five" in the fourth line of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the word 'two,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 121. Secretary of State authorized to destroy records more than two years old. The secretary of state is hereby authorized to remove and destroy all records and papers in his office pertaining to the registration of motor vehicles and the issuance of operators' licenses which are more than two years old and are not in use, and which in his judgment are no longer of value.'
