AN ACT Relative to Night Hunting

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-five of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word "from" in the second line thereof, the words 'three-quarters of an hour after,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 45. Night hunting prohibited; exception. 1929, c. 331, s. 35. There shall be a closed season on wild birds in this state from three-quarters of an hour after sunset to half an hour before sunrise of the following morning, and on wild animals from one hour after sunset until one hour before sunrise of the following morning, during which closed season it shall be unlawful to hunt, kill or destroy any wild bird or wild animal of any kind except skunks and raccoons, as provided in section seventy-two. No person shall have in possession, at any time, any wild bird or wild animal, or part thereof, taken in violation of any provision of this section.'
