STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Allowances from Estates of Decedents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section nineteen of chapter seventy-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the last word in said section the words, 'and in the same manner may make allowances for the guardian of the minor children of her husband should the husband be deceased,' so that said section when amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 19. Allowance to husband from his wife's estate. Upon the death of a wife whose estate is solvent, the judge may make an allowance to her husband from her personal estate, in the same manner as to a widow from the estate of her husband. And in the same manner may make allowances for the guardian of the minor children of her husband should the husband be deceased.'
