AN ACT Relating to Temporary Orders in Libels for Divorce

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section seven of chapter seventy-three of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word "vacation" in the first line thereof, the words 'or the judge of the Probate Court for the county where said libel is returnable,' so that said section when amended will read as follows:

'Sect. 7. Court may free wife from restraint pending libel. Pending a libel, the court, or any justice thereof in vacation, or the judge of the Probate Court for the county where said libel is returnable, on petition of the wife, may prohibit the husband from imposing any restraint on her personal liberty; and enforce obedience by appropriate processes.'
