STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Catching of Smelts in Fresh Water Streams.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Restriction of smelt catching. Section twenty-nine of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the first paragraph of said section the following paragraph:

'Provided, however, it shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch, or kill any smelt at any time, by any means, in any of the fresh water brooks or streams and branches thereof which flow directly into tide-water.'
