RESOLVE, Extending Open Season on Penobscot Stream.

Open season on Penobscot Stream, extended. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation extending the open season for fishing in Penobscot Stream, so-called, in Hammond Township, for a period of thirty days.
