STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Fees for Jurors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Jurors' fees. Section 6 of c. 126 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 6. Fees of jurors. Grand and traverse jurors, attending the superior court, and jurors attending on any other occasion prescribed by law, shall be allowed four dollars a day for their attendance, **Sundays and holidays excepted**, and six cents a mile for their travel out and home, to be paid out of the county treasury.'
