STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Judges of Probate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 75, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 75 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Judges, how selected; terms commence, when. Judges of probate are elected or appointed as provided in the constitution. Only members of the Maine bar may be elected or appointed as judges of probate. Their election is affected and determined as is provided respecting county commissioners; and they enter upon the discharge of their duties on the first day of January following; but, when appointed to fill vacancies, their terms commence on their appointment.'
