IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Snow Removal.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 28, amended. Chapter 28 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered § 52-A, and to read as follows:

'Sec. 52-A. Winter routes to extend to end of highway. When the state highway commission lays out a winter route for snow removal it shall extend it to the end of the particular highway route, or to the border of the state so that the whole of that particular road shall come under the provisions of law relating to snow removal.'
