# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to the Taking of Smelts from the Tital Waters of Penobscot Bay, Blue Hill Bay and Union River Bay.

Smelt fishing in certain tidal waters, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation forbidding the use of seines or gill nets in the catching of smelts between November I and April I of each year in the tidal waters of Penobscot Bay, beginning at Dice's Head at Castine, including Eggemoggin Reach, Blue Hill Bay, Union River Bay and their tributaries as far east as the bridge connecting the town of Trenton with Mount Desert Island including all rivers, harbors, and inlets connected with the before mentioned waters; excepting that this rule and regulation shall not apply to the catching of smelts in traps set for sardines and herring.
