RESOLVE, Relating to Lucerne-in-Maine.

Emergency Preamble. Whereas, c. 43 of the private and special laws of 1927 has imposed too great a burden on the town of Dedham, and

Whereas, its repeal is immediately necessary in order to properly assess taxes at the town meeting in March, and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of § 16 of article 31 of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, now, therefore, be it

Resolved: That c. 43 of the private and special laws of 1927 is hereby repealed.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency recited in the preamble this resolve shall take effect when approved.
