STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Motor Vehicles Carrying Passengers for Hire over Regular Routes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- **R. S. c. 66, § 2, amended.** Section 2 of chapter 66 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 2. Commission to make rules and regulations governing use of said motor vehicles. Said commission is hereby authorized to make from time to time rules and regulations governing the operation of said motor vehicles which shall include provisions concerning the route of operation, schedule to be operated and maintained, rates of fare to be charged for the carriage of passengers, the safeguarding of passengers and other persons using the streets and highways, and such other reasonable regulations as may be deemeed necessary for the safety or convenience of the public. The power and authority conferred upon the public utilities commission in section 59 of chapter 62 is hereby made applicable to the provisions of this chapter.'
