STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Closing Pleasant River and Tributaries to Trapping.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Trapping regulated in Pleasant river. For a period of 3 years from the time this act becomes effective, it shall be unlawful for any person to hunt, trap, kill, pursue or catch any wild animal at any time in Pleasant River and all its tributaries, to high water mark, said waters being situated in the towns of Columbia and Columbia Falls, in the county of Washington.
