## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Fishing in Parlin Stream.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Parlin stream closed to fishing. The commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to close to all fishing Parlin Stream, in Parlin Pond township, from the foot of Parlin Pond to the fish screen at the head of the "Falls", under the rules and regulations of the department.
- Sec. 2. P. L. 1931, c. 277, § 9, repealed. Section 9 of c. 277 of the public laws of 1931 is hereby repealed.
