IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing for Pickerel in Oxford and York Counties.

Fishing regulated in Oxford and York counties. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation placing a bag limit on pickerel in all waters within the counties of Oxford and York of fifteen fish or twenty-five pounds for each person each day.
