IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Stanley Ponds in Hiram and Porter.

Fishing regulated in Stanley Ponds. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby, directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting the taking of any salmon in Stanley ponds, so-called, in the towns of Hiram and Porter in the county of Oxford, less than 16 inches in length and further prohibiting the taking of more than 2 salmon in all, in any 1 day, by any 1 person in said ponds.
