RESOLVE Relating to Stocking of Pleasant Pond, in Sumner, with Trout.

Pleasant Pond to be stocked with trout. Resolved: That the commissioner of fish and game is hereby directed to stock Pleasant Pond, in the town of Sumner, with trout, and that the customary regulations be imposed thereon.
