RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Matthews Pond in the Towns of Hebron and Oxford in Oxford County.

Length of trout taken regulated in Hebron and Oxford. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing the legal length of trout taken from Matthews Pond, located in the towns of Hebron and Oxford in Oxford county, at 10 inches.
