STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Authorize the Town of Winslow to Use Party Designations on Ballots for Town Meetings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Winslow may use party designations on ballots. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 44 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes the municipal officers of the town of Winslow may in the preparation of ballots for town meetings, list the candidates by parties and under a party designation; the separate party lists to be arranged as required by said section alphabetically according to surnames.
