RESOLVE, For Investigating Lighting Costs in York County.

Public Utilities Commission investigate electric current cost in York County. Resolved: That the public utilities commission be and hereby is directed to investigate the costs, charges and fees for electric current used for municipal and domestic consumption within the cities and towns in the county of York, and determine whether such rates, fees and charges are fair, or unreasonable and discriminatory.
