IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for Town Line Signs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Markers for town lines. The state highway commission is hereby authorized and directed to place suitable markers on all trunk line roads and all state aid roads designating the point of entry and exit to and from the several cities and towns along the lines of said highways; the expense of the making and placing of such signs to be charged against the general highway fund.
