## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Directing the State Highway Commission to Make a Bridge Survey Across Eggemoggin Reach.

Highway commission to make bridge survey across Eggemoggin Reach. Resolved: That the state highway commission be, and hereby is, instructed to cause its engineering department to make a preliminary survey to determine the approximate cost and feasibility of constructing a bridge across Eggemoggin Reach from Little Deer Isle to the main land at Byards Point in the town of Sedgwick; the expense of the survey to be paid from the general highway fund, if and when available, and not to exceed in the aggregate of \$1000.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve is introduced for the purpose and feasibility and probable cost for the construction of a bridge from Little Deer Isle to Byards Point to serve a vital need of a community.
