STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Regulate the Distribution of Public Funds to Hospitals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Condition attached to hospital appropriations. All hospitals in this state which receive any public funds, that have been or may at any future time be appropriated to assist in the care of residents of the state, shall admit to practice therein the licensees of the board of osteopathic examination and registration of said state, who are in good standing and are qualified to practice obstetrics and surgery according to the laws of the state.
