STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Closing Libby Brook, in Fort Fairfield.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. **Fishing in Libby Brook regulated.** For a period of 3 years from the time this act becomes effective, it shall be unlawful for any person to fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time in the waters of Libby Brook, said brook being situated wholly in the town of Fort Fairfield, in the county of Aroostook.

It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in possession at any time any kind of fish taken in violation of any provision of this Act.

Sec. 2. **Penalty.** Whoever violates any provision of this act shall be subject to a penalty of not more than \$300.00 and costs, or imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both said fine and imprisonment.
