IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Frederick A. Furbish.

Frederick A. Furbish granted right to take fish in Belgrade Stream. Resolved: That Frederick A. Furbish, of Mt. Vernon, is hereby authorized and empowered to take eels and suckers from Belgrade Stream by means of screens and traps placed on his own land and contiguous waters.
