## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Closing Pleasant Pond Stream.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Fishing in Pleasant Pond stream regulated. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time in the waters of Pleasant Pond Stream, which stream is located wholly in the plantation of Caratunk, in the county of Somerset.

It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in possession at any time any kind of fish taken in violation of the provisions of this act.

Sec. 2. **Penalty.** Whoever violates any provision of this act shall be subject to a penalty of not more than \$300.00 and costs, or imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both said fine and imprisonment.
