IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Baker Stream.

Fishing in Baker Stream, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all fishing, Baker Stream in township 4, range 6, and township 5, range 6, and township 4, range 5, and township 5, range 7, all in B. K. P. W. K. R., except fly fishing during the general open season on Wednesday and Saturday of each week and to prohibit taking more than 10 fish in all per person per day or more than 5 pounds of fish in all unless the last fish taken increases the combined weight thereof to more than 5 pounds.
