STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of Parsonsfield Seminary.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Charter of Parsonsfield Seminary amended. Section 2 of chapter 249 of the public and special laws of 1901 is amended by striking out the whole of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The board of education shall consist of 5 members, namely: the state commissioner of education, or the officer representing the state in the management of the public schools; the superintendent of public schools of the town of Parsonsfield, or such officer as may represent the town in that capacity; the chairman of the board of selectmen of said town, or other officer performing his duties; and 2 members of the board of trustees to be chosen annually by and from said board.'

- Sec. 2. Control of Bartlett Doe fund. And the said act is further amended by adding thereto an additional section to be known as section 5, to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 5. Expenditure of Bartlett Doe fund. The board of trustees of said Parsonsfield Seminary shall have exclusive control of expenditures of the income of said Bartlett Doe fund and said board of trustees, by its duly authorized officers, shall draw all drafts upon funds in the possession

of said Boston Safe Deposit and Trust Company, and such drafts shall be accompanied by a certificate of said board of education of said Parsonsfield Seminary that the amounts to be drawn are due the said trustees under the terms of said deed of trust.'
