STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT To Forbid School Committees Employing Relatives as Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. School committees not to employ relatives. It shall be unlawful for the superintending school committee in any town to employ as a teacher in the schools of the town any person related to any member of the superintending school committee within the degree of second cousin.

Sec. 2. **Penalty.** Any contract of employment made in violation of the provisions in section I hereof shall be null and void and no compensation shall be collected under such contract.
