IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to Ice Fishing in the Towns of Porter and Hiram.

Ice fishing in towns of Hiram and Porter regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation fixing the season for ice fishing for trout and salmon in the waters situated in the towns of Porter and Hiram to from December 16th to the last day of February, both days inclusive.
