STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Ogunquit Beach District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L. 1923, c. 105, § 3, amended. Section 3 of c. 105 of the P. & S. L. of 1923 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. First meeting, how called; regular and special meetings, how called. The first meeting of said corporation shall be called by petition of seven legal voters within said district, directed to any justice of the peace within said state, who shall issue his warrant to any constable within the town of Wells to call said meeting within said district at a time, place and for the purposes indicated therein.

The regular meetings of said district shall be called within said district by a majority of the trustees thereof in the same manner as is provided by statute for calling town meetings, and shall be held on the fourth Tuesday of August April annually.

Special meetings shall be called by a majority of the trustees, upon request of seven legal voters, within said district, and held in the same manner as provided for the calling of town meetings.'
