IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Taking of Lobsters During July and August.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Lobster taking regulated. The commissioner of sea and shore fisheries is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting the taking of lobsters during the months of July and August in Washington county waters from the Canadian boundary line extended to the Hancock county line extended.
