STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relative to Sunday Hunting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 44 of chapter <u>38</u> of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 44. Sunday hunting. Sunday is a closed season, on which it is not lawful to hunt any wild animals or wild birds of any kind, excepting any Sunday which falls within the dates when it is lawful to hunt partridge, duck or deer.'
