STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTYTHREE

AN ACT Relating to the Presque Isle Town Government.

Emergency Preamble. Whereas, the continuance of the authorized form of town government of the town of Presque Isle is necessary to preserve the credit of that town and any change from the form of government approved at the annual town meeting held in March, 1932 would tend to impair the financial stability of the town and would bring about a chaotic condition in town affairs, and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section 16 of article 31 of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, now therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Discontinued privilege, repealed. Section 19 of chapter 100 of the private and special laws of 1931 is hereby repealed.

Emergency Clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble hereof, this act shall take effect on approval.
