STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Prohibiting Hunting from Automobiles and Transportation of Firearms Therein.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 38, § 46, amended. Section 46 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt any wild bird or wild animal at any time from an automobile, or by aid or use of any light or lights carried thereon or attached thereto. It shall be unlawful for any person to have in possession at any time, any wild bird or wild animal, or part thereof, taken in violation of any provision of this section. No person shall have a rifle or shotgun any firearms either loaded or with cartridge in a magazine thereof, in or on any motor automobile, or any other vehicle while the same is upon any highway, or in the fields or forests.'
