STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Prohibiting the Horning of Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Horning of deer prohibited. Chapter 38 of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

'Sec. 61-A. Horning of deer prohibited. It shall be unlawful to drive deer by the use of horns, whistles or other noise making device.'
